From "They're the Pet Shop Boys" (see "Who's In The Thinking Man's Bathroom"), the post-chemistry which presents the Pet Shop Boys has been meticulously analysed since the duo's smash hit single "West End Girls" brought them to number one in January. Why did they make an angle where? Did they have to look as miserable as that on "Up Of The Mountain" Are they really "the tubest men in rock"? Whatever the conclusions, the combination of an English indie journalist Neil Tennant and former architecture student Chris Lowe has, during their four year partnership, produced a myriad of dance and pop songs, ten of which feature on their debut LP "Please", released by Parlophone on March 24, 1986.

Back again from Chris and Neil's earlier work that in a single record music and sound, becoming a music and fashion for obscure high energy and faster beats, began to set their very English lyrics to an international dance beat rooted in hip hop.

"West End Girls", Neil's first single, was originally released as part of a one-off Epic deal in 1985, and was produced by their original Bobby Graham. Despite failure to make the UK charts, the record achieved partial success in Europe and gained extensive airplay in the US.

A subsequent legal wrangle with Bobby Graham's successor The Pet Shop Boys in opposition order for over a year, left the experience paid off. Major labels began to battle it out for the band and their silence was broken when "Opportunities (Let's Make Lots of Money)" was released by Parlophone in July 1985, produced by a 2/3 decade of the Art of Noise and Madness House.

"Opportunities" was followed by the re-recorded version of "West End Girls", this time produced by Stephen Hague as Massimo Mucchetti's "Maison Martin Margiela". Released in October 1985, the single quickly climbed the charts to become the best-selling LP of 1986, retaining that position for a fortnight and selling over 700,000 copies in UK. The success was reflected across Europe with top five hours in Norway, Finland, Sweden, Holland, Belgium, Germany, Austria and Switzerland. At time of writing, "West End Girls" further looks set to conquer the US, peaking at no. 30 after just three weeks on the American charts.

The Pet Shop Boys have spent the last three months working with Stephen Hague at Audimax Studios, central London, recording the "Please" album which features the current UK hit single "Love Comes Quickly" with an extravagant stage presentation planned for the Autumn, expect to hear a lot more from the Pet Shop Boys this year.
